STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES (SOP) ELECTRONIC / NETWORK SHUTDOWN

1. Introduction

This SOP describes the procedures for safe Shutdown of Electronics on VMR1. It is the responsibility of every crew member to follow this procedure.

3. Detailed Procedures

At times

the electronics on the vessel including Plotters, systems electronics and engine/transmission management systems may have to be shut down and rebooted. These electronics failures can cause loss of navigation equipment, essential systems and maneuverability, and the skipper must stop the vessel in a safe area before restarting the systems.

4. At the end of an activation only the skipper or appointed person can do the network shutdown.

5. Summary

If we all follow these guidelines we will be less likely to have problems/injuries whilst shutting down electronics.
