STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES (SOP) SAFE USE OF SHORE POWER CABLE

1. Introduction

This SOP describes the procedures for safe use of the Shore Power Cable on VMR1. It is the responsibility of every crew member to follow this procedure.

3. Detailed Procedures

The Shore Power Cable should be positioned so that no person stands or trips on it, this should prevent damage to the cable and remove a tripping hazard.

Before departure the cable must be disconnected from the vessel and stored on the jetty in such a way that it, and the power pedestal on the jetty, does not get damaged.

The disconnection and stowage is part of the visual check by Master and crew before departure.

4 Summary

If we all follow these guidelines we will be less likely to have problems/injuries whilst using the Shore power cable.
